"BECAUSE OF LOVE" CHARITY CONCERT RETURNS TO RAISE FUNDS FOR REN CI HOSPITAL & ASSUMPTION PATHWAY SCHOOL

- Chyi Yu joins hand with Wakin Chau for a night of Love and Gratitude

Singapore, 18 January 2017 – After the successful Love and Remembrance Charity Concert 《怀念~因为有爱》慈善演唱会 in November 2015, the second instalment of the trilogy of concerts sponsored by Goh Lee Hiang Memorial Fund (GLHMF) will return on Saturday 6 May 2017 at The Star Theatre, The Star Performing Arts Centre.

Titled Love & Gratitude Charity Concert 《感恩~因为有爱》慈善演唱会, Taiwanese superstar Chyi Yu will partner her long-time friend Wakin Chau for this one-night only charity concert. Both artistes will perform pro bono to raise funds for two charities, namely Ren Ci Hospital and Assumption Pathway School.

Ren Ci Hospital was the sole beneficiary in the first charity concert. For this second charity concert, GLHMF aims to raise at least \$2 million for two charities and Assumption Pathway School has been chosen as the 2nd beneficiary for their commitment to provide alternative educational pathway for the less academically inclined students in Singapore. Both of these charity organisations will share in the proceeds of this fundraising.

With over 60 albums between them, this charity concert brings together Chyi Yu and Wakin for the first time in Singapore for a charitable cause. They promise to stir reminiscence with their repertoire of Mandopop classics and popular hits, including their duet "Lovers of The World"《天下有情人》.
