



# Supporting Clients in Swallowing: Screening and Exercises

Care staff function as the “eyes and hands on the ground” for therapists in the community settings as they interact with clients on a regular basis. Having adequate knowledge would enable care staff to promptly identify potential swallow related issues and flag them to speech therapist for follow up. In this course, participants will learn how to conduct bedside swallow screening, how to ensure safety in feeding, and indirect swallow exercises to target swallow deficits in patients.
