



Introduction in managing challenging behaviour

It is important for health care staff to be able to detect cognitive impairment in elders. Knowing the cognitive ability of the elder would allow the health care staff to pitch activities at an appropriate level of challenge and facilitate the elder's engagement in activities of daily living as the elder is able to. Signs and symptoms of cognitive impairment can be recognized through how elders perform their tasks or through screening assessments. In this course, participants would learn to identify cognitive impairment through observations and screening assessments and the basic strategies to maximize participation.
